Sight for Students Gift Certificate Program

Stephens County Communities in Schools has partnered with Sight for Students to offer a gift certificate for a free eye exam and glasses if needed to students who failed their vision screening but who, for financial reasons, are unable to secure proper follow-up diagnosis and prescription glasses.

There are five basic qualifications a child must meet in order to receive a Sight for Students gift certificate.

1. Family income is no more than the chart below
2. Child is not enrolled in Medicaid or other vision insurance.
3. Child is 18 years old or younger and has not graduated from high school.
4. Child or parent is a U.S. citizen or legal immigrant with a social security number.
5. Child has not used the Sight for Students program during the past 12 months.
